**Today is the 34th Sunday After Pentecost & Sunday of the Publican and Pharisee. In honor of the Publican, we enjoy a fast-free week!**

**Today Fr. Justin will publicly demonstrate the Proskomedia Rite** at 9am in the nave for the Sunday School classes and all others who wish to come. Every Orthodox Divine Liturgy is preceded by this rite in which the bread and wine are prepared to be offered and is usually done on the altar by the priest prior to the service.

**Vespers on Wednesday, February 12 at 6:30pm.** The Christian Education class will watch a film featuring Fr. Roman Braga. Bring snacks if you want since this is a fast-free Wednesday.

**Spring Visitor Sunday is next Sunday, February 16!** This is a great time to invite your friends, neighbors, co-workers to come experience an Orthodox Service. We will be just 2 weeks out from our Lenten journey leading us to Pascha. What a great time to share our faith. Who will you invite?
