In order to allow for open attendance at Divine Liturgy on Sundays, Parish Council has created "The Open Church" plan which is two teams of parishioners who will rotate praying in the nave one Sunday and the parish hall the next. The hall has been setup as a "church" with icons, candlestands, distancing dots, large screen w/ projector for livestreaming. This weekend Team Peter (last name A-M) will be praying in the nave and Team Paul (last name N-Z) will be in parish hall. All parishioners will have the opportunity to receive the Eucharist. (PLEASE NOTE: HOLY COMMUNION IS ONLY GIVEN TO ORTHODOX CHRISTIANS WHO HAVE KEPT FAST, MADE RECENT CONFESSION, AND ARE AT PEACE WITH NEIGHBORS.)

All other services, Wednesday Vespers, Saturday Vigil, and special weekday feast services will be completely open (no rotation/no signup). Primary Services [Wednesday Vespers, Saturday Vigil, Sunday Liturgy] will be livestreamed on our St. Athanasius YouTube channel.

It is important to note that we will continue to practice strict guidelines regarding sanitation, distancing, masking, etc. Greeters will be both upstairs and downstairs to greet you and direct you to hand washing stations, take attendance, and answer your questions.

Some Special Considerations

- ★ Do not come if: 1) you are a medical professional caring directly for COVID patients; 2) you have been exposed to COVID or are caring for someone with COVID; 3) you have any flu-like symptoms.
- ★ Respect the place-marker dots that are on the floors at 8 feet intervals.
- ★ Volunteers needed to help clean/sanitize after each service.

Feast of Holy Apostles Peter and Paul will be observed with Vigil this Sunday at 6:30pm (confessions following) and Liturgy on Monday the 29th at 10am.
