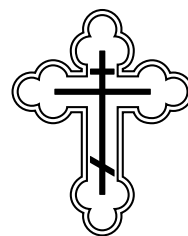

The **Baptism of Elizabeth Lourie**, infant daughter of Joshua and Crystal Olga Lourie, will take place on Wednesday, June 16 at 6:30pm (no Vespers Service). Following the Baptism, Fr. Justin will teach the final class on Orthodox Social Teachings.

An **Akathist for Departed** (in anticipation of Memorial Saturday) will be prayed on Friday, June 18 at 11am. Father will hear confessions after the service.

Next Sunday is the Feast of the Holy Trinity!

We will commemorate this most special feast with the following services:

- ❖ **Vigil for Pentecost** at 6:30pm Saturday, June 19
- ❖ **Divine Liturgy on Sunday at 9:30am (new time for summer months)**
- ❖ **Kneeling Vespers** on Sunday at 10:45am

Immediately after Kneeling Vespers, we will head to High Bridge State Park located at KY 29 and Old Park Road in Wilmore. The parish has rented the pavilion at the park which sits on top of the famed River Palisades, overlooking the Kentucky River Gorge. Everyone is invited to join us for a parish picnic and an afternoon of fun and fellowship.
