Forward in Faith Campaign / Second Priest Search Update

Our parish leadership has met many times over the last three weeks to continue the work of finding a second priest. These weeks have been incredibly fruitful. New possibilities have presented themselves. At present, we have identified an extraordinary seminarian. Not only the parish council, but also the diocese and the seminarian himself seem very committed to moving forward with us. The only downside to this candidate, in the view of the parish council, is that he and his family cannot arrive until May 2024. (This candidate and his family do plan to visit and finalize our mutual commitment in August--so we will begin a year of getting to know one another!)

Since we were introduced to this seminarian, the parish leadership has also become acquainted with an OCA priest who is in the process of retiring. He and his wife are investigating if they can make Kentucky work. While they may not end up in Kentucky, the council is considering inviting them to visit. In semiretirement, this priest could still help meet needs for us in the coming year (until our seminarian arrives) and be a third priestly presence around the church in the years to come. It is possible the council will invite this priest and matushka to visit at some point in the summer, as well.

While the council makes no predictions about what is going to happen, the parish leadership is excited about these serious conversations and are confident that the Lord is guiding us along the way. Thank you for continued prayerful and financial support for our Forward in Faith Campaign!
